SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarships will be awarded each year. Scholarship recipients will be awarded \$1,250 to assist with textbooks and other learning resources.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to apply for a scholarship, you must meet all of the following criteria:

- Be an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person
- Studying a health or community services related course or degree
- Be a resident of the Central Coast or Mid North Coast
